About Us

The Palais Theatre in Franklin has been the most prestigious hall in the Huon Valley since it was constructed in 1911. It has been lovingly restored in the last 20 years and has retained all its magnificent heritage features boasting one of the most impressive pressed tin ceilings in Australia. The Palais is a popular venue for weddings and private parties and functions as well as being regularly used for community classes and markets.

What we do

The Palais is owned by the Huon Valley Council but is managed by a committee of volunteers – the Palais Management Committee. This Committee ensures that the theatre is well maintained, oversees all bookings for functions and organises upgrades of theatre assets and services.

The Palais Management Committee is supported by the Friends of the Palais who volunteer to assist where necessary, particularly in ensuring that our beautiful theatre is always looking her best and in the running of Palais run events such as the regular movie night.

Volunteers can become involved with the Palais as much or as little as they wish. Elections for the Palais Management Committee are held each year for those who want to be directly involved with the running of the Palais.
